High-velocity, low-amplitude (HVLA) thrust manipulation of the cervical spine is an integral skill for all physical therapists. This course is designed to help therapists and students who are not currently comfortable with these interventions. We will practice only 3 techniques to ensure that participants gain a mastery in these skills. This lab course will be designed to maximize hands-on practice with short lectures and group discussions.

During the lab, participants will have expert supervision and guidance from multiple Fellows of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapists and other therapists with advanced training in manual therapy.
